

ORDINANCE NO. 1756

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PERFORMING ARTS DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Auditorium Commission should be abolished and all duties and responsibilities of the commission transferred to the Department of Performing Arts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That Chapter 12.10 of the Eureka Springs, Arkansas Municipal Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

12.<sup>10</sup>~~04~~.01. There is hereby established the Department of Performing Arts for the City of Eureka Springs. The department head shall be appointed as set out in applicable State law.

12.<sup>10</sup>~~04~~.02. The Department of Performing Arts shall be responsible for running, operating and maintaining the City Auditorium Convention Center of the City and for developing and ~~and~~ establishing rules for its operation.


12.<sup>10</sup>~~04~~.03. In order for the Department to develop and implement its programs and to facilitate the transition from a commission to a department, there is hereby established an advisory committee, consisting of three members, who shall assist the department head to develop a comprehensive, community-oriented plan that will promote and enhance to use of the facilities. After the development of the plan, the committee shall meet at the call of the department head and shall provide assistance to the department head during the City's budgetary process.

12.<sup>10</sup>~~04~~.04. The members of the committee shall be appointed by the Mayor, confirmed by a majority vote of the City Council and serve for a period of two (2) years.


Section 2. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.
