

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1798

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1653, SECTION 2.40.10, "FIRE DEPARTMENT," OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has determined that Section 2.40.10, "Fire Department," of the municipal Code should be amended in order to regulate efficiently the charges for ambulance and related services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By The City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that:

Section One: Amendment to Section 2.40.10

A portion of Section 2.40.10 shall be amended to read:

2.40.10, Ambulance and Related Services:

The Fire and Ambulance Department is hereby authorized to access the following charges for ambulance and related services in the providing of emergency medical services to members of the public requesting or in need of such services:

EUREKA SPRINGS AMBULANCE SERVICE:

Advance Life Support Service Fee - \$375.00

Mileage -	\$4.50 per mile-from origin to final destination.
Oxygen -	\$20.00
Extrication -	\$100.00
Waiting Time -	\$30.00 for every half hour

Any attempts to establish an Intravenous Infusion, will be charged for all supplies needed, even if the attempts are unsuccessful.

Medicare Formula for miscellaneous supplies as follows:

COST OF SUPPLY:

Less Than \$.50	= \$1.00 + Cost
\$.50 - \$1.00	= \$2.00 + Cost
\$1.00 - \$10.00	= By 2.5
\$10.00- \$20.00	= By 2.2
\$20.00 - \$50.00	= By 1.9
\$50.00 - \$100.00	= By 1.8
\$100.00- \$500.00	= By 1.6


Medicare Formula for medicines as follows:

AVERAGE WHOLESALE PRICE (AWP) of Drugs divided by the amount per case, then multiply cost per item by 2.85 = the allowable cost of Medicare.

Section Two: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
