

**ORDINANCE NO. 2162**

**AN ORDINANCE READOPTING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF TITLE 7, CHAPTER 7.52, SIGNS, THAT WERE INADVERTENTLY MISNUMBERED**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs (“the city”) has determined that its ability to properly enforce Chapter 7.52, Signs, of the Municipal Code will be enhanced by the re-numbering of certain sections to eliminate any ambiguous references to said chapter and to enable proper enforcement of same.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council does not intend to change any of the currently approved language and has thoroughly reviewed each section of this chapter to ensure the current, approved language remains as written.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:**

**Section 1.** That the attached Title 7, Chapter 7.52, Signs of the Eureka Springs Code as amended as of August 13, 2007, is hereby readopted as if set out herein and the Eureka Springs City Clerk is hereby directed to send the same to the current code service for inclusion in the current Eureka Springs Municipal Code.

**Section 2.** That Ordinances # 1399, # 1634-A, # 1660, # 1951, # 1782, #1818, # 1848, #1940, #2027, #2037 and # 2100 or parts of any ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are repealed in their entirety.


**Section 3.** That in the event that any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or other provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance, Code, code section or chapter as a whole or any part, or provision, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional, and the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, Code, code section or chapter shall remain in effect.

Emergency Clause

**Section 4.** That due to the need to consistently apply all laws and ordinances of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, for the health and safety of the citizens of the City; an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon passage by the Eureka Springs City Council and signing by the Eureka Springs Mayor and City Clerk/Treasurer.
