

ORDINANCE NO. 2168

AN ORDINANCE TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR WIDENING AND PAVING 820 FEET OF LAKE LUCERNE ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Lake Lucerne Road is in disrepair due to the construction of the new high school; and,

WHEREAS, Lake Lucerne Road needs to be widened due to navigational conflicts with buses, it does not meet requirements of the International Building Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has researched the cost and availability of firms capable of making the repairs needed

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That the City Council of Eureka Springs does hereby waive the competitive bidding requirements of the Arkansas Code Annotated and the Eureka Springs Municipal Code to allow for the contracting by the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, with Tomlinson Asphalt Company, Inc., in an amount of up to \$38,000 for the widening and paving of Lake Lucerne Road from the intersection of Greenwood Hollow Rd for a distance of 820 ft.;


Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to transfer said necessary sums from the Street Reserve Fund to cover said expenses

Emergency Clause

Section 3. That due to the immediate need for repairing and widening of Lake Lucerne Road for the opening of the new high school, for the student drivers, buses, and emergency traffic within the City, for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City; an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage by the Eureka Springs City Council and signing by the Eureka Springs Mayor.
