

**ORDINANCE No. 2180**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE SUB-SECTION 8.48**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has reviewed the current Code Subsection 8.48 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code; and,

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of the City to amend the subsection;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That Subsection 8.48 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

8.48.01 Managed by the City. Any person desiring to park any vehicle within a parking space on any parking lot owned or managed by the city between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. shall deposit in U. S. currency the proper amount for the time desired into the designated space's parking meter, as the fee therefore.


8.48.02 Short term parking cost. The rate for parking in a city owned or operated short-term parking lot is \$1.00 in change per hour from 8:00 a. m. to 6:00 p.m., 7 days per week; including holidays, unless changed by the City Council by ordinance or resolution.

**SECTION 2.** Severability Clause: In the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or other provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance, code section or chapter as a whole, or any part or provision other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional, and the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, code section or chapter shall remain in effect.

**SECTION 3.** Repeal Clause: All Ordinances, Resolutions, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
