

ORDINANCE No. 2193

AN ORDINANCE RECLAIMING AUTHORITY OVER PART OF THE UNOPENED PORTION OF PALO PINTO AVENUE FROM THE PARKS COMMISSION'S AUTHORITY PREVIOUSLY GRANTED OVER GREEN SPACE WITHIN THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City Council previously placed green space within the City under the authority of the Parks Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to possibly dispose of a part of the unopened portion of Palo Pinto Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the Parks Commission and Planning Commission have been consulted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the following part of the unopened portion of Palo Pinto Avenue is removed from the authority of the Parks Commission as it has been previously granted over green space within the City:


A part of Palo Pinto Avenue and a part of Ojo Street as shown on the plat of survey for the Freeman Addition to the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Begin at the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 1, said Freeman Addition, thence North to a point located on the North side of said Palo Pinto Avenue, thence East along the North side of said Palo Pinto Avenue to a point on the East side of said Ojo Street, said point on Ojo Street being located by a prolongation of the North line of said Palo Pinto Avenue, thence South along the East side of said Ojo Street to a point that is created by a prolongation of the North line of Lot 1, Block 1, said Freeman Addition, thence West along said prolonged line and the north line of Lot 1, Block 1, said Freeman Addition to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. Repeal Clause: All Ordinances, Resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
