

ORDINANCE No. 2194

AN ORDINANCE RECLAIMING AUTHORITY OVER PART OF THE UNOPENED PORTION OF NUT STREET FROM THE PARKS COMMISSION'S AUTHORITY PREVIOUSLY GRANTED OVER GREEN SPACE WITHIN THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City Council previously placed green space within the City under the authority of the Parks Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to possibly dispose of a part of the unopened portion of Nut Street; and,

WHEREAS, the Parks Commission and Planning Commission have been consulted

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the following part of the unopened portion of Nut Street is removed from the authority of the Parks Commission as it has been previously granted over green space within the City:

A portion of Nut Street, lying between Block 221 and Cold Spring Reservation, in the Armstrong Survey of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the most southern point of Cold Spring Reservation (N43 degrees 24'27"E) corner of Lot 1 of said Block 221 along the southwest line of said Nut Street, 30.7 ft. wide and 379.99 ft. long.

SECTION 2. Repeal Clause: All Ordinances, Resolutions, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
