

ORDINANCE NO. 2250

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL, PURSUANT TO THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE, TO RECLAIM JURISDICTION OVER CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED IN DAIRY HOLLOW

WHEREAS, the City Council of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has been petitioned to vacate and/or exchange certain land now held as a Green Zone by the Parks and Recreation Commission; and

WHEREAS, Section 12.08.01(E) of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code allows the City Council to reclaim jurisdiction over the following sections of Green Zone to make further discussions of the petition.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That the unnamed approximately 10 foot wide strip of property running northeast from Dairy Hollow Rd between Lots 4, 5 and 6 of Block 79 and Lots 1 and 2 of said Block 79 as surveyed and platted by Eureka Improvement Company and an unnamed strip of land varying from approximately 30 to 60 feet wide running southwest from Dairy Hollow Rd between Block 71 and Block 79 as surveyed and platted by Eureka Improvement Company is hereby removed from the jurisdiction of the Parks and Recreation Commission for further reconsideration by the City Council of Eureka Springs, Arkansas.

Section 2. That provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be separable and if any provision shall for any reason be held illegal or invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.


Section 3. All ordinances and solutions and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
