

ORDINANCE NO. 1813 A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS CLASSIFYING SERVICES PROVIDED FOR THE CITY ADVERTISING AND, PROMOTION COMMISSION AS PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH SERVICES SHALL BE PROCURED IN THE MANNER PROVIDED BY LAW; AMENDING SECTION 4.32.04(d) OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY OF PROVISIONS.

WHEREAS, the City Advertising and Promotion Commission is interested in contracting with certain entities and persons to provide consulting and administrative assistance to the Commission, and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas believes that the services to be contracted for rely in large part upon individual skills of the entity or persons contracted with, and that, as such, it is impractical to bid such contracts, and such services shall hereby be classified and designated as "professional services" and procured as set out in applicable state law.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:


Section One: That Section 4.32.04(d) of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

4.32.04(d) The Commission shall have the authority to employ the necessary personnel to assist in the administration and operation of the Fund and shall have the authority to fix the salary or salaries of such personnel. Any employee who shall handle funds for the Commission shall be required to furnish the City a surety bond in the amount provided in Section 4.32.02, Paragraph 1. Further, the Commission shall have the authority to contract for "professional services" as hereby defined as "Advertising Specialties" and shall include the work of festival director, media buyer, events coordinator, promotion coordinator, and specialists in other areas, general and specific, requiring expertise related to the operation of the City Advertising and Promotion Commission, and, that this shall not restrict the authority of the Commission to contract other professional services as provided by State law.

Section Two: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. *Passed 7-15-99.*
