

**ORDINANCE NO. 1821**

**AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PRESERVATION OF TREES  
IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Eureka Springs was founded in a great natural forest hundreds of years old; and

WHEREAS, the people of Eureka Springs are grateful for the multitude of trees which grace our City, and the care of our natural heritage is of primary importance to all who live, visit and work here; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Eureka Springs to preserve existing trees and to encourage the planting of new trees; and

WHEREAS, it has therefore been determined by the City Council that it is necessary to have an ordinance setting out regulations regarding the preservation of Eureka Spring's trees.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: That the attached Section of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas be adopted for this purpose. This section will replace section 14.5.19 of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas which is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

Section Two: That each of the provisions of this ordinance are severable and the decision of any court as to the validity of any provision shall not effect the remaining portions

Section Three: If this ordinance is in conflict with any other ordinance or resolution of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, then such other Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section Four: If this ordinance is in conflict with the terms of any utility franchise agreement, then this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section Five: That this ordinance shall go into full force and effect thirty days after its passage.
