

ORDINANCE NO. 1839

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8.28, ONE-WAY STREETS,
AND DESIGNATING A PORTION OF BENTON STREET AS A
ONE-WAY STREET, AND AMENDING CHAPTER 8.16,
PARKING, SECTION 8.16.06-2, "EXTRA PROVISIONS,"
AND ESTABLISHING PARKING SPACES ON BENTON STREET**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs has determined that the flow of traffic into and out of the downtown historic district would be enhanced and improved by designating a portion of the street commonly known as Benton Street (Benton Street) as one-way beginning at the East (lower) bad weather gate and running uphill to the corner of the intersection of Benton Street and Midway Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs has determined that fifty-six (56) free parking spaces should be established on the South curb of Benton Street between the bad weather gates; NOW, THEREFORE

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS,
ARKANSAS:**

1. That Chapter 8.28 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is amended by the addition of section 08 which shall read as follows:

Section 8.28.08 One-Way Vehicular, Benton Street. It shall be unlawful for any vehicle, motorized or unmotorized, to be driven or otherwise operated on Benton Street from the East (lower) bad weather gate to the corner of the intersection of Benton Street and Midway Street in any direction other than a southwesterly direction (uphill). Two-way traffic shall be permitted on Benton Street from the East (lower) bad weather gate descending downhill to the intersection of Benton and Main Street.

2. That Chapter 8.16, Section 8.16.06-2 "Extra Provisions" of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is amended by the addition of section 61 which shall read as follows:

Section 8.16.06-2 Extra Provisions.

61. Fifty-six (56) free parallel parking spaces, each a minimum of twenty-two (22) feet in length, are established on the South curb of Benton Street between the bad weather gates. The West (upper) bad weather gate is 146 feet northeast (downhill) from the intersection of Benton Street and Midway Street. The East (lower) bad weather gate is 1,251 feet northeast (downhill) from the West (upper) bad weather gate.

3. That all ordinances or resolutions, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
