

ORDINANCE NO. 1868

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS,
AMENDING SECTION 2-144 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE,
AMENDING THE DUTIES OF THE CITY ATTORNEY
TO INCLUDE THE HOSPITAL COMMISSION, PARKS
AND RECREATION COMMISSION, AND
HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized by Arkansas Code Annotated 14-43-314 to establish the duties and responsibilities of the City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, the Hospital Commission of the City of Eureka Springs has requested the City Council to include representation of the Hospital Commission as part of the regular duties of the City Attorney;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that Section 2-144 of the Municipal Code should be amended to include representation of the Parks and Recreation Commission and the Historic District Commission as part of the regular duties of the City Attorney; **NOW, THEREFORE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

1. That Section 2-144, subsection (b) of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:
 - (b) The city attorney shall be legal counsel to the city advertising and promotion commission, the city cemetery commission, the city planning commission, the city board of adjustment, the city parks and recreation commission, the city historic district commission, and the city hospital commission. The city attorney shall attend meetings of these commissions and board upon sufficient notice and at the specific requests of the respective chairmen of the commissions and board.
2. That Section 2-144, subsection (e) of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code shall be amended to strike, or delete, the last sentence of subsection (e) which states: "However,

this subsection and subsection (c) of this section shall not apply to the city hospital commission."

3. That all ordinances or resolutions, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
4. That each of the provisions of this ordinance are severable and the decision of any court having jurisdiction as to the validity of any provision shall not effect the remaining provisions.
5. That this ordinance shall go into and be of full effect thirty (30) days after its passage.
