

ORDINANCE NO. 1964

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO
ELIMINATE TROLLEY STOP #83 UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2004, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Eureka Springs, AR, has determined that it is in the best interests of the city to try and improve shopping on upper Spring Street;

WHEREAS, it appears that many tourists are leaving the trolley at stop #83 before reaching the shops on upper Spring Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, AR:

Section 1. That Trolley Stop Number #83 will be eliminated for the remainder of the year through December 31, 2004.

Section 2. If any part of this ordinance is declared unenforceable for any reason whatsoever, it shall not effect the remaining parts.

Section 3. That all ordinance and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said ordinance.

Section 4. That whereas time is of the essence in that the tourist season is now well under way, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
