

ORDINANCE #1968

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS AND DELARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. LEVY ON PERSONAL PROPERTY

A tax of 4.4 mills on the dollar is hereby levied on all personal property situated within the City limits of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas for the following purposes:

SECTION 2. LEVY ON REAL PROPERTY

A tax of 4.4 mills on the dollar is hereby levied on all real property situated within the corporate limits of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas for the following purposes:

SECTION 3. COLLECTIONS

The 4.4 mills above levied on the personal property are to be collected at the regular collection of taxes by the Collector of Carroll County, Arkansas, at the same time and in the same manner that State and County taxes are collected in the year 2005.

The 4.4 mills above levied on the real property are to be collected at the regular collection of taxes by the Collector of Carroll County, Arkansas, at the same time and in the same manner that State and County taxes are collected in the year 2005.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY

It has been found and is hereby declared an emergency, that a levy and collection of taxes is necessary for the continuance of municipal service to the residents of Eureka Springs, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and is so declared, whereby this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
