

ORDINANCE NO. 1970

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2004 ADOPTED BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEY FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD MAY 11, 2004.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, made a comprehensive study and review of the budget and on June 28, 2004 adopted Ordinance Number 1963 that appropriated funds for a special election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has been advised by the County Clerk for Carroll County that the amount appropriated in Ordinance 1963 does not reflect the total costs for the special election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. This Ordinance shall be known as Special Election Amendment Two to the Amended Budget Ordinance for the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, for the year of 2004. All revenues and appropriations are based on estimated revenues; and all estimates are subject to change during the budgetary period.

Section 2. That the amount of the additional expenditure needed to fund the special election is \$450.00 and insomuch as it was not a budgeted item, the 2004 budget is hereby amended to reflect these additional costs of the May 11, 2004 Special Election. The transfer of the above stated sum from the General Fund to pay for the said election is hereby approved by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas; and it is hereby authorized and appropriated for the purposes set forth.
