

Ordinance # 1976

An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance # 1897 Establishing the Duties and Salary of the Clerk Treasurer for the City of Eureka Springs and Amending the Duties of the City Clerk Treasurer

WHEREAS, in order to best serve the citizens of the City of Eureka Springs, the responsibility of the position of the City Clerk Treasurer, shall be redefined; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas State Code 14-43-506 defines the duties of the Clerk Treasurer in a city of the first class with a population of less than 50,000, the city shall reinstate the duties of the Clerk Treasurer as follows;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained, by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

1) That the duties of the Office of City Clerk Treasurer shall be those set by applicable Arkansas law.

2) That the Clerk Treasurer shall be responsible for the minutes of the Eureka Springs City Council, the Eureka Springs Planning Commission and Board of Adjustment, and the Eureka Springs Historic District Commission.

3) That the Clerk Treasurer shall keep all the City records, minutes, ordinances, resolutions and copies of the Municipal Code and Municipal Fire Code and the seal of the City of Eureka Springs.

4) That the Clerk Treasurer shall sign all permits and licenses for the city of Eureka Springs, in coordination with the Office of the Mayor excluding those issued by the Building Official.

5) That the salary for the office of the Clerk Treasurer shall be Twenty

Eight Thousand Dollars, (\$28,000.00) which is effective February 13, 2005.

6) That the Ordinance 1897 as codified in Section 2-122 and Section 2-123 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is hereby specifically repealed.

7) All Ordinances and Resolutions, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith repealed to the extent of such conflict.

8) In the event any one or more of the provisions contained in this Ordinance shall for any reason be held by a Court of Law to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, and this Ordinance shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision or provisions had never been contained herein.
