

ORDINANCE NO. 1024

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION I. LEVY. A tax of Fifteen (15) Mills on the dollar is hereby levied on all real and personal property situated within the corporate limits of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, for the following purposes:

| 6. Voluntary mills, Hospital Support | 1 mill |

SECTION II. COLLECTION. The Fifteen (15) Mills above levied are to be collected at the regular collection of taxes by the Collector of Carroll County, Arkansas, at the same time and in the same manner that State and County taxes are collected for the year 1977. The voluntary millage for Hospital Support is applicable to the Western District of Carroll County only.

SECTION III. EMERGENCY. It has been found, and is hereby declared, that a levy and collection of taxes is necessary for the continuance of municipal services to the residents of Eureka Springs, and for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and is so declared, whereby this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
