

ORDINANCE NO. 1029

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 968  
OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS,  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCREASING THE TAP  
FEES AND THE RATE CHARGED BY THE CITY  
FOR WASTE WATER SERVICES PROVIDED BY  
THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the first and second enumerated paragraphs  
of Ordinance No. 968 were amended, in their entirety, by Ordinance  
No. 993, passed and approved by the City Council of the City of  
Eureka Springs, Arkansas, on the 20th day of December, 1975, for the  
purpose of increasing the tap fees and the rate charged by the City  
for waste water services provided by the City; and

WHEREAS, the said City Council has found that it is  
essential to the health, safety and welfare of the City and its  
inhabitants that the said tap fees and the said rate charged by  
the City for waste water services provided by the City be further  
increased to meet increased costs of operation and maintenance:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The first enumerated paragraph of Ordinance No. 968  
of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, is hereby amended to  
provide, in its entirety, as follows:

A fee shall be chargeable for each tap on the  
Municipal Sewage System, with the fee therefor to be  
One Hundred and Fifty and No/100 Dollars (\$150.00).

SECTION 2. The second enumerated paragraph of Ordinance No. 968  
of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, is hereby amended to  
provide, in its entirety, as follows:

The monthly rate for waste water services shall  
be at a minimum rate of One and 95/100 Dollar (\$1.95)  
for the first 2,000 gallons of water used and Fifty  
Cents (50¢) per thousand for each additional thousand  
gallons. Statements for waste water service shall not  
be rendered more often than monthly, and may be

rendered in conjunction with the statements for water service, and if not paid within ten (10) days from the due date thereof, a penalty of ten percent (10%) of the amount of the statement shall be added. In the event the statement shall not be paid within fifteen (15) days of the due date, water services to the user will be discontinued. Service may be restored only after such time as payment of all delinquent charges and penalties for water and waste water services, together with the payment of a reconnection charge of Two and 50/100 Dollars (\$2.50), have been made.

SECTION 3. The remainder of said Ordinance No. 968 is hereby confirmed and ratified, and the same shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 993 of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, and all other ordinances, resolutions and parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be held to be unenforceable or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not render the remainder of this Ordinance to be unenforceable or invalid.
