

ORDINANCE NO. 1034

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARAGRAPH (d) of SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1031, EFFECTIVE MARCH 18, 1978.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, TO-WIT:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (d) of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 1031 of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, is hereby amended to read, in its entirety, as follows, to-wit:

"(d) The Commission shall, through its Chairman (or Vice-Chairman) and Secretary-Treasurer (or Assistant Secretary-Treasurer) have the authority to sell and convey burial lots, plots or parts thereof to the general public, and to prepare (or cause to be prepared), execute, acknowledge and deliver proper instruments of conveyance to such purchasers. The Commission shall establish the purchase price of all available lots and plots at a regular meeting, and the same shall remain in effect until changed at a subsequent regular meeting."


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect on March 18, 1978, being the effective date of said Ordinance No. 1031.
