

ORDINANCE NO. 1045

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1043 OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, WITH RESPECT TO THE PORTION OF PINE STREET TO BE RESTRICTED TO ONE-WAY VEHICULAR TRAFFIC IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION OR A SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION TWELVE (12) MONTHS EACH YEAR, SEVEN (7) DAYS EACH WEEK AND TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS EACH DAY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1043 AMENDED.

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1043 of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, is hereby amended to read, in its entirety, as follows, to-wit:

"From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any vehicle, motorized or un-motorized, to be driven or otherwise operated at any time on Pine Street in any directions other than an easterly direction or a southeasterly direction, and Pine Street shall, by virtue of this Ordinance, be deemed to be a one-way street in an easterly direction or a southeasterly direction from its intersection with Prospect Avenue to a line extended from the southwest corner of Lot 3, Block 27, across Pine Street to the northwest corner of Lot 3, Block 29, provided that two-way traffic shall continue to be permitted on Pine Street from said line extended across Pine Street to the intersection of Pine Street with Spring Street, all as shown on the Riley and Armstrong Plat of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas. Any person violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court of Eureka Springs, be deemed guilty of a Class "C" Misdemeanor and shall be fined in a sum not exceeding One Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$100.00) nor less than Twenty-five and No/100 Dollars (\$25.00)."

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on October 29, 1978, being the effective date of said Ordinance No. 1043.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

Each word, phrase, sentence and section of this Ordinance is severable from each and every other word, phrase, sentence and section hereof. If any part of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional and/or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not render the remaining parts hereof ineffective, and the same shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. REPEAL

All Minute Orders, Resolutions and Ordinances, and parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


