

ORDINANCE NO. 1046

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH RESPECT TO OBTAINING COMPREHENSIVE GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE AND COMPREHENSIVE AUTOMOBILE COVERAGE THROUGH TUCKER-BLAND-HELMS INSURANCE & REAL ESTATE AGENCY FOR THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, is in dire need of obtaining comprehensive general liability insurance and comprehensive automobile coverage; and

WHEREAS, Tucker-Bland-Helms Insurance & Real Estate Agency has submitted an acceptable proposal for such insurance and coverage; and

WHEREAS, Act 28 of 1959 provides, in Section 5, that the City Council of said City, by ordinance, may waive the requirements of competitive bidding in exceptional situations where such procedure is not feasible or practical; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of said City has found that in the matter of obtaining such insurance and coverage, the requirements of competitive bidding would be both unfeasible and impractical, as well as useless and wasteful:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REQUIREMENTS OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING WAIVED.

The requirements of competitive bidding are hereby waived with respect to obtaining comprehensive general liability insurance and comprehensive automobile coverage through Tucker-Bland-Helms Insurance & Real Estate Agency for the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY DECLARED.

The City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has found that an emergency exists with respect to obtaining adequate and sufficient comprehensive general liability insurance and comprehensive automobile coverage for the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, and that the same must be obtained without unnecessary delay in the interest of the general welfare and safety of said City and its inhabitants and visitors. Therefore, an emergency

is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication according to law.

PASSED AND ORDAINED, WITH SECTION 2 PASSED SEPARATELY, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, ON THIS 14TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1978.
