

ORDINANCE NO. 1063

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH RESPECT TO THE REPAIR OF THE PUMP FOR CITY WATER WELL NUMBER THREE.

WHEREAS, the pump for City Water Well Number Three is in urgent need of repair in order to function properly; and

WHEREAS, Sheldon Knuth, doing business as Knuth Electric and Well Service, is knowledgeable with respect to the water well pumps of the City through actual work experience; and

WHEREAS, the said Sheldon Knuth has submitted a written estimate to the City for labor and materials required to remove the old magnetic starter from the pump for City Water Well Number Three and to install therein a new size number four automatic transformer with a reduced voltage starter for a one hundred horsepower sub-water pump, in the total sum of three thousand five hundred dollars, with such work to be commenced immediately upon completion of preliminary work with respect thereto by Layne-Western Co. of Kansas City, Missouri, and with payment to be made to the said Sheldon Knuth upon completion of such work by the said Sheldon Knuth; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found that the repair of the pump for City Water Well Number Three constitutes an exceptional situation within the spirit and letter of Act 28 of 1959 of the Acts of Arkansas and that the requirements of competitive bidding with respect to the same should be waived, inasmuch as such procedure is deemed not feasible or practical.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Competitive bidding requirements waived.

Competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived with respect to the repair of the pump for City Water Well Number Three, and Sheldon Knuth, doing business as Knuth Electric and Well Service, is hereby authorized to commence and complete such repair in accordance with his aforesaid written estimate submitted to the City.

Section 2. Emergency declared.


