

ORDINANCE NO. 1066

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5.16 OF THE  
EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS,  
ARKANSAS.

Section 1. Chapter 5.16 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code  
amended.

Chapter 5.16 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is hereby  
amended to read, in its entirety, as follows, to-wit:

Chapter 5.16

LITTER CONTROL

Sections:

- 5.16.01 Declaration of purpose
- 5.16.02 Certain provisions of Litter Control Act adopted  
by reference.

5.16.01 Declaration of purpose. The purpose of this chapter  
is to accomplish the control of litter, inoperative household  
appliances and junk motor vehicles throughout the city by  
regulating their disposal. The intent of this chapter is to add  
to existing litter control, removal and enforcement efforts and  
not to terminate or supplant such efforts, as well as the compatible  
goal of improving the quality of life for all the citizens of the  
city. To that end, this chapter is supplemental to Chapters 5.08  
and 8.12 of this Code and is not intended to supercede or repeal  
their respective provisions.

5.16.02 Certain provisions of Litter Control Act adopted  
by reference. The provisions of Sections 2  
through 16 of Act 883 of 1977, Acts of Arkansas, cited and known  
as the "Litter Control Act", and presently codified as Ark.Stat.Ann.  
§§82-3902 through 82-3916 (Suppl. 1977), are hereby adopted by  
reference to form a part of the laws of the city, and three (3)  
copies thereof are on file in the clerk/treasurer's office.  
Any person being found guilty of the violation of Sections 4, 6  
or 10 of the Litter Control Act shall be deemed guilty of the  
violation of the ordinances of the city, and shall be fined or  
imprisoned or both in the manner set out under the Litter Control  
Act.

Section 2. Emergency declared.

The City Council has found that this Ordinance is essential to  
the effective control of the proper disposal of litter, inoperative  
household appliances and junk motor vehicles throughout the city and  
to the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of and  
visitors to the city. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist  
and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage,  
approval and publication according to law.
