

ORDINANCE NO. 1095

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12, EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE, BY ADDING A CHAPTER THERETO, ENUMERATED AS CHAPTER 12.08, FOR THE PURPOSE OF DECLARING CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS LANDS OWNED BY THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, TO CONSTITUTE A CITY PARK KNOWN AS WATER STREET PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Title 12, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, amended.

Title 12, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, is hereby amended by adding a chapter thereto, enumerated as Chapter 12.08, for the purpose of declaring certain contiguous lands owned by the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, to constitute a city park, said Chapter 12.08 being as follows, to-wit:

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Chapter 12.08

WATER STREET PARK

Sections:

- 12.08.01 Water Street Park established
- 12.08.02 Contiguous lands comprising Water Street Park
- 12.08.03 Purpose of Water Street Park

12.08.01 Water Street Park established. Certain contiguous lands lying within the corporate limits of the City and owned by the City, the boundaries thereof being set forth in Section 12.08.02 of this Chapter, are hereby declared to constitute a city park, and the same is hereby established as Water Street Park.

12.08.02 Contiguous lands comprising Water Street Park. The contiguous lands comprising Water Street Park are as follows, to-wit:

(a) That portion of Laundry Spring Reservation bounded on the west by Water Street, on the north by the southerly boundary line of Block 184 extended to the center line of Flint Street, on the east by the center line of Flint Street extended to the northerly boundary line of Perrin Avenue, and on the south by the northerly boundary line of Perrin Avenue, all as shown on the Riley and Armstrong Survey Plat of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas; and

(b) That portion of Sweeney Street bounded on the west by Water Street, on the north by the southerly boundary line of Block 172, on the east by the westerly boundary line of Little Eureka Reservation, and on the south by the northerly boundary line of Block 142, all as shown on the Riley and Armstrong Survey Plat of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas; and

(c) That portion of Maxwell or Cave Spring Reservation bounded on the east by Water Street, on the south by the northerly boundary line of Block 171, on the west by the extended easterly boundary line of Douglas Street, and on the north by the southerly boundary line of Block 174, all as shown on the Riley and Armstrong Survey Plat of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas; and

(d) All of Water Street, beginning at its southerly intersection with Douglas Street and thence proceeding in a northerly direction to a straight line formed by connecting the northernmost points of Block 181 and Block 182, all as shown on the Riley and Armstrong Survey Plat of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas.

12.08.03 Purpose of Water Street Park. Water Street Park is established to be used and enjoyed by the public as a public recreational park.

Section 2. Severability.

If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. Repeal.

Each minute order, resolution and ordinance or each part thereof which is in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.
