

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF PARTS AND SUPPLIES FOR THE CITY'S WATER AND SEWER TREATMENT FACILITIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: Competitive bidding requirements waived.

The competitive bidding requirements of Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, are hereby waived with respect to the purchase of parts and supplies for the City's water and sewer treatment facilities in the amount of \$2,923.50 (plus freight charges and taxes). Competitive bidding is not deemed practical or feasible as only one company exists which supplies the needed parts (identified on the attached purchase order). The Mayor, or her authorized representative, is hereby authorized to contract with Infilco Degremont, Inc. of Richmond, Virginia for the purchase of the parts and supplies.

Section 2: Emergency declared.

The need for parts and supplies for the City's water and sewer treatment facilities is such that a delay in the receipt of the parts and supplies will pose a threat to the proper operation and functioning of the facilities. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and, this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
