

ORDINANCE NO. 1121

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CALLING AND HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF THE ADOPTION OF A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Call of Election.


By virtue of the passage of Ordinance No. 1120 and under the authority of Arkansas Statutes Section 19-4514 (c) (1980 Replacement), a special election to consider adoption of a sales and use tax as described in said ordinance is hereby called to be held on June 23, 1981 to consider the question of the adoption of a one per cent (1%) sales and use tax on the receipts of retail sales within the City.

Section 2. Emergency declared.


It is hereby found by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas that unless a sales and use tax is levied in accordance with this Ordinance the City will suffer a serious financial crisis and City services and functions will need to be drastically reduced or eliminated. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, it shall take effect and be in full force from the date of its passage, approval and publication according to law.
