

ORDINANCE NO. 1123

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A WATER WELL PUMP FOR THE CITY'S WATER WELL #2 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: Competitive bidding requirements waived.

The competitive bidding requirements of Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, are hereby waived with respect to the purchase of a water well pump for the City's water well #2 in the amount of \$2,700. Competitive bidding is not deemed practical or feasible as only one company exists that can provide the necessary pump in the time required. The time necessary to make the purchase through the competitive bidding process would interfere with water service to the entire City and jeopardize the health of the City.


The Mayor, or her authorized representative, is hereby authorized to contract with Evans Electric of Rogers, Arkansas for the purchase of the water well pump.

Section 2: Emergency declared.

The need for a water well pump for the City's water well #2 is such that a delay in the receipt of the pump will pose a threat to the proper operation and functioning of the facility. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and, this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

PASSED AND ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, WITH SECTION 2 BEING READ AND PASSED SEPARATELY ON THIS 24 day of June, 1981.
