

ORDINANCE NO. 1130

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 1979 RULES AND REGULATIONS  
FOR ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS FOR NEW BUILDING CON-  
STRUCTION OF THE ARKANSAS ENERGY OFFICE, AND DECLARING  
AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

WHEREAS, ACT 7 of 1981, Acts of Arkansas requires cities with building permit requirements for new construction or for renovation of existing structures to adopt the 1979 Rules and Regulations for Energy Efficiency Standards for New Building Construction of the Arkansas Energy Office; and

WHEREAS, the City of Eureka Springs is subject to the mandates of Act 7 of 1981, Acts of Arkansas.

Now, THEREFORE, be it ordained as follows:

Section 1. Section 11.04.01, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, amended.

Section 11.04.01, Eureka Springs Municipal Code is amended by designating the existing section as subsection (a) and addition of the following subsection:


(b) All new construction or renovation of existing structures within the corporate limits of the City shall be done in compliance with the Rules of Regulations for Energy Efficiency Standards for New Building Construction of the Arkansas Energy Office. The Building Inspector shall be responsible for insuring compliance with said rules and regulations and every building permit shall be issued subject to adherence to said rules and regulations. Said rules and regulations are hereby adopted by reference in their entirety and, to the extent that they are inconsistent with the requirements of the Southern Standard Building Code, they supercede said code. Not less than three (3) copies of said rules and regulations have been filed in the office of the Building Inspector of the City for inspection, copying and reference by all interested persons.

Section 2. Emergency declared.

The City Council hereby finds that the adoption of the rules and regulations of the Arkansas Energy Office are necessary to comply with Act 7 of 1981, Acts of Arkansas, which went into effect on July 1, 1981. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, it shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication according to law.
