

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING
REQUIREMENTS FOR THE REPAIR OF
PUMP AND MOTOR FOR WATER WELL NO.
3, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS,
ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. BIDDING REQUIREMENTS WAIVED

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the City Council finds that the repair of Water Well No. 3 requires repair of the pump and motor and that adherence to the bidding requirements is not feasible or practical. It appears that the bidding process would delay the repairs to the extent that the City could have to rely for an extended period of time on the other wells; any malfunction of the other wells could jeopardize the City's water supply while awaiting repairs on the pump and motor for Water Well No. 3. Therefore, the bidding requirements are waived.

SECTION 2. CONTRACT AUTHORIZED


The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are authorized to enter into a contract with Layne-Western Company, Inc. of Kansas City, Missouri and any subcontractors or parts suppliers for the repair of the pump and motor for Water Well No. 3.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY DECLARED

The City finds that an emergency exists because of the needed repairs to the pump and motor for Water Well No. 3, and without making immediate repairs the City's water supply is threatened. To protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City, this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its passage.
