

ORDINANCE NO. 1146

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE CEMETERY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS

SECTION 1. Section 2.60.01(b), Eureka Springs Municipal Code, amended.

Section 2.60.01(b), Eureka Springs Municipal Code, is hereby amended by deletion of the entire subsection and substitution in its place the following:

(b) Each member of the Commission shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age. Further, each member shall be a qualified elector and resident of the Western District of Carroll County, Arkansas, although any appointment shall be filled so far as practicable by a qualified elector and resident of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas.

SECTION 2. Prior appointments ratified and confirmed.

All appointments to the Commission made prior to the effective date of the ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed so long as each of them otherwise qualifies under the terms of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Emergency delared.

An emergency is found to exist because there does not appear to be qualified city residents who are willing to serve on the Cemetery Commission and the Commission is likely to be unable to transact its business. Therefore, to protect the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its publication.
