

ORDINANCE NO. 1147

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS
FOR THE PURCHASE OF A BACKHOE AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS

SECTION 1. Bidding requirements waived.

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the purchase of a 1981 Case Model 580C backhoe/loader are hereby waived. The bidding requirements are not deemed feasible or practical because the machine has been offered to the City for purchase at a 25% discount; unless the City takes immediate advantage of the discount opportunity an equivalent machine will never be available at such a savings.

SECTION 2. Contract authorized.

The Mayor and Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Potter Equipment Company of Harrison, Arkansas for the purchase of the machine at a price of \$22,475.00 plus tax.

SECTION 3. Emergency declared.

The City Council finds that an emergency exists because of the factors mentioned in Section I of this ordinance and because of the needed repairs to the City's broken water and sewer lines. Therefore, to protect the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its publication.
