

ORDINANCE NO. 1152

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING
REQUIREMENT FOR THE REPAIR OF
BENTON STREET, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION I. Competitive bidding requirements waived.

On March 24, 1982 there was published in the Arkansas Gazette a notice inviting bids for the repair and construction of Benton Street, a public street within the corporate limits of Eureka Springs. There were three bids received, all of which were substantially over the estimate provided by McClelland Consulting Engineers, Inc. Therefore, no contract was awarded to any of the construction companies.

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the repair of Benton Street are hereby waived. The bidding requirements are not deemed feasible or practical because of the continued deterioration of Benton Street and compliance with the bidding requirements will unduly delay repairs.

SECTION II. Contract authorized.


The Mayor and the City Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Hamilton-Patten Construction Co., Inc. of Mt. Vernon, Missouri for the repair of Benton Street at a cost not to exceed \$83,000.00.

SECTION III. Emergency declared.

The City Council finds that an emergency exists because of the factors mentioned in Section I. and because Benton Street presents a safety hazard. Therefore, to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Eureka Springs, Arkansas this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its passage.
