

ORDINANCE NO. 1167

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING
REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF
MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS,
ARKANSAS:

SECTION I. COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS WAIVED.

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the purchase of motor vehicle liability insurance, are hereby waived. The bidding requirements are not deemed feasible or practical because the Arkansas Municipal League offers a substantially lower rate through the liability insurance program it offers and the present coverage is due to expire on December 1, 1982. Therefore, the bidding requirements are waived.

SECTION II. CONTRACT AUTHORIZED.

The Mayor and City Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Arkansas Municipal League for motor vehicle liability insurance in an amount not to exceed \$4,246.00.

SECTION III. EMERGENCY DECLARED.

The City Council finds that an emergency exists because of the factors mentioned in Section I. Therefore, to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Eureka Springs, Arkansas this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its passage.
