

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY FIRE
DEPARTMENT TO ASSESS CERTAIN CHARGES FOR
AMBULANCE AND RELATED SERVICES AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS,
ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Section 2.40.10, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, adopted.

Section 2.40.10, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, is hereby adopted
to read in its entirety as follows:

2.40.10 Ambulance and related services.

The Fire Department is hereby authorized to assess
the following charges for ambulance and related
services in the provision of emergency services
to members of the public requesting or in need
of such services:

Emergency	\$ 55.00	
Non-emergency	40.00	
Mileage	1.00	loaded mile
Waiting time	40.00	per hour
Oxygen	12.00	
Cervical immobilization	20.00	
Child delivery	25.00	
Airway management	15.00	
Thumper or CPR	50.00	
IV or drug therapy	20.00	unless supplies replaced
Splinting	5.00	per extremity
Monitor	10.00	
Extrication	100.00	

Section 2. Emergency delcared.

It appears that the revenues to be derived by the City from the
schedule of charges above are needed by the City to balance its
proposed budget for the year 1983. Therefore, an emergency is declared
to exist, and to protect the health, welfare and safety of the residents
of the City, this ordinance shall be effective from and after the
date of its publication.
