

ORDINANCE NO. 1175

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CALLING AND HOLDING OF  
A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF THE  
ASSESSMENT OF CERTAIN CHARGES FOR AMBULANCE  
AND RELATED SERVICES AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Call of Election.

By virtue of petitions presented to the City Clerk's office on February 15, 1983 and the same being certified as legal petitions, a special election to consider the assessment of certain charges for ambulance and related services as were described in Ordinance No. 1169 passed by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs on the 25th day of January, 1983 is hereby called to be held on June 7, 1983 to consider the question of assessing certain charges for ambulance and related services.

Section 2. Emergency Declared.

It is hereby found by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas that due to these petitions being filed that an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, it shall take effect and be in full force from the date of its passage, approval and publication according to law.
