

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING
REQUIREMENTS FOR THE REPAIR OF LINWOOD
AVENUE AND MIDWAY STREET (HIGH SCHOOL ST.)
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION I. COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS WAIVED.

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the resurfacing of Linwood Avenue and Midway Street (High School St.) are hereby waived. These streets were destroyed or damaged while city crews were trying to replace or repair broken water lines after a long period of freezing weather. The Bidding requirements are not deemed feasible or practical because the cost of resurfacing these streets is at a discount price; and unless the City takes immediate advantage of the discount opportunity the necessary repairs can not be done. Therefore, the bidding requirements are waived.

SECTION II. CONTRACT AUTHORIZED.

The Mayor and City Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with McClinton-Anchor Company, a Division of Apac-Arkansas, Inc. for the resurfacing of Linwood Avenue and Midway Street (High School St.) at a cost not to exceed \$6,500.00.

SECTION III. EMERGENCY DECLARED.

The City Council finds that an emergency exists because of the factors mentioned in Section I. and because Linwood Avenue and Midway Street (High School St.) presents a safety hazard. Therefore, to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Eureka Springs, Arkansas this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its passage.
