

ORDINANCE NO. 1205

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8.20.05 AND SECTION 8.20.06 OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE, WHICH REGULATES THE PARKING METER ZONES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 8.20.05 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

(a) Courthouse Parking Lot.

Front and back lots 13, 14, 15, 17, 18 and front and back lot 16, less and except that portion of said lot on which the Western District Courthouse is located, all in Block 156, R & A Survey to the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas. That no parking meters shall be placed on spaces immediately adjoining the Courthouse on the North side as same shall be reserved for the use of the County or those persons having Courthouse business.

SECTION 2. Section 8.20.06 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

(a) Courthouse Parking Cost on Lot #1

Any person desiring to park any vehicle within a parking meter space on the "Courthouse Parking Lot #1" (south side) shall deposit the proper coins for the time desired as follows:

Twelve Minutes	05¢
Twenty-four Minutes	10¢
One Hour	25¢

(b) Courthouse Parking Cost on Lot #2

Any person desiring to park any vehicle within a parking space on the "Courthouse Parking Lot #2" (north side) shall deposit the proper fee in the Lot Parking Box, said fee shall be displayed on the parking box.

SECTION 3. Severability

If any part of this Ordinance is held to be unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Emergency Declared

The City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has found that the parking fees on the Courthouse Parking Lot #1 and Lot #2 were

inadequate and that increasing the fees is essential to efficient governmental operations for the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Eureka Springs and that this ordinance is necessary for the promotion and preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication according to law.
