

ORDINANCE NO. 1210

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE TRANSFER AND ASSIGNMENT OF THE TWIN LAKES TELEVISION COMPANY FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, SETTING FORTH TERMS AND CONDITIONS ACCOMPANYING THE APPROVAL OF THE ASSIGNMENT AND TRANSFER OF SAID FRANCHISE:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs has granted a franchise to the Twin Lakes Television Company to construct, operate and maintain a cable television system in the City of Eureka Springs said franchise being dated December 10, 1977 and being for a term of fifteen (15) years, and

WHEREAS, Twin Lakes Television Company has now sold its cable television system to Teleservice Corporation of America, a Texas Corporation authorized to do business in Arkansas, and

WHEREAS, representatives of Twin Lakes Television Company and Teleservice Corporation of America have appeared before the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs and discussed the proposed sale and demonstrated to the Council that the proposed buyer has the legal character, financial, technical and other qualifications required to continue satisfactory cable television service to the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. APPROVAL OF TRANSFER

The City of Eureka Springs hereby approves the transfer and assignment of the Twin Lakes Television Company franchise to Teleservice Corporation of America; that Teleservice Corporation of America shall be bound by all terms and provisions of the franchise granted to Twin Lakes Television Company pursuant to Ordinance No. 1026 dated December 10, 1977; that Twin Lakes Television Company shall be relieved of any further responsibilities to the City of Eureka Springs pursuant to said Ordinance and franchise effective the date Teleservice Corporation of America assumes operation of the cable television system.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY DECLARED

It has been found and decided by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that there is an urgent need to approve the transfer of this franchise as hereinabove set out and that a delay in implementing said transfer and assignment would be detrimental to the interest of the people of the City of Eureka Springs. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist

and this ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
