

ORDINANCE NO. 1220

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS  
FOR THE PURCHASE OF A USED 580 SUPER E BACKHOE  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS

SECTION 1. BIDDING REQUIREMENTS WAIVED.

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the purchase of a used 580 Super E Backhoe are hereby waived. The bidding requirements are not deemed feasible or practical because the backhoe is needed immediately; because other available backhoes in a similar price range have not been located; and because other dealers have indicated that the price is very fair.

SECTION 2. CONTRACT AUTHORIZED.

The Mayor and Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Potter Equipment Co. of Harrison, Arkansas for the purchase of the backhoe at a price of \$15,200.00 plus tax.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY DECLARED.


The City Council finds that an emergency exists because of the factors mentioned in Section 1. of this ordinance and because of the need of the backhoe for the Street and Water & Sewer Departments. Because of the bad condition of the present truck \$3,100. plus tax would need to be spent on repair. Therefore, to protect the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the date of its publication.
