

ORDINANCE NO. 1228

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS
FOR ENGAGING FIRM TO BORE UNDER STATE HIGHWAY
62 WEST AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

Section 1. Bidding Requirements Waived

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 3.04.03 Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the provision of engaging a drilling firm to bore under State Highway 62 West for the purpose of installing a necessary water line are hereby waived because the bidding requirements are not deemed feasible or practical. There is only one firm in the area licensed to do this work.

Section 2. Contract Authorized

The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract with John Boatwright to complete necessary boring work at the above site.

Section 3. Emergency Declared.

The City Council finds that the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary to preserve the public health and safety of the citizens of Eureka Springs, Arkansas. Therefore, this ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage according to law.
