

ORDINANCE NO. 1247

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8.20.06 OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE, WHICH REGULATES THE PARKING METER ZONES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS

SECTION 1: Section 8.20.06 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

8.20.06 Courthouse Parking Costs:

a. Courthouse Parking Cost on Lot #1: Any person desiring to park any vehicle within a parking meter space on the "Courthouse Parking Lot #1" (south side) shall deposit the proper coins for the time desired as follows:

Six Minutes	05 ¢
Twelve Minutes	10 ¢
Thirty Minutes	25 ¢
One Hour	50 ¢

b. Courthouse Parking Cost on Lot #2: Any person desiring to park any vehicle within a parking space on the "Courthouse Parking Lot #2" (north side) shall deposit the proper fee in the Lot Parking Box, said fee shall be displayed on the parking box.

c. Other Parking Metered Areas: Any person desiring to park any vehicle within a parking meter zone shall deposit the proper coins for the time desired as follows:

Six Minutes	05 ¢
Twelve Minutes	10 ¢
Thirty Minutes	25 ¢
One Hour	50 ¢

SECTION 2. Severability

If any part of this ordinance is held to be unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the remaining parking of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Emergency Declared

The City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has found that substantial loss of revenue shall occur if this ordinance is not enacted immediately, and it is essential to efficient governmental operations of the City of Eureka Springs and is necessary for the promotion and preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication according to law.

PASSED AND ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, WITH SECTION 3 BEING VOTED UPON SEPARATELY ON THIS 8TH DAY OF APRIL, 1986.
