

ORDINANCE NO. 1250

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7.28.02 (e)
OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE TO
DELETE THE EXEMPTION FOR BANNERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has found upon the recommendation of the City Planning Commission, that Chapter 7.28 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code in regard to signs is inadequate to preserve the public peace, health and safety of the City of Eureka Springs, and should be amended without delay;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: That Chapter 7.28, Signs, of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is hereby amended to read, as follows:

Chapter 7.28.02(e) Part 8, is deleted.

Section 2: Chapter 7.28.03, General Restrictions, is hereby amended as follows:

(h) No banner crossing above any street shall be permitted except those specifically authorized, promoted or regularly scheduled by the Eureka Springs Chamber of Commerce.

Section 3: Emergency Declared


