ORDINANCE NO. 1281

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8.28, SECTION 8.28.02
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS,
ARKANSAS

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

That Chapter 8.28, Section 8.28.02 of the Municipal Code, City
of Eureka Springs, Arkansas is amended to read as follows:

8.28.02 One-Way Vehicular, Mountain Street. It shall be unlaw-
ful for any vehicle, motorized or unmotorized, to be driven or other-
wise operated on West Mountain Street from the intersection of West
Mountain Street with Spring Street to the intersection of West Moun-
tain Street with Eureka Street, all as shown on the Riley and Armstrong
Plat of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, in any direction other
than a westerly direction from 12:01 o'clock a.m. on the 1st day of
April of each calendar year until 12:00 o'clock midnight of the 31st
day of October of the same calendar year. Two-way traffic shall be
permitted in easterly and westerly directions on said portion of West
Mountain Street from 12:01 o'clock a.m. on the 1st day of November of
each calendar year until 12:00 o'clock midnight of the 31st day of
March of the immediately following calendar year.

Also on Lower Mountain Street from Center Street to North Main Street
it shall be unlawful for any vehicle, motorized or unmotorized to be
driven or otherwise operated on Lower Mountain Street, all as shown on
the Riley and Armstrong Plat of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas,
in any direction except easterly. The size of the vehicle shall not
be larger than 3/4 ton pickup truck.

Any person violating this Chapter shall, upon conviction thereof in
the Municipal Court of Eureka Springs, be deemed guilty of a Class "C"
misdemeanor and shall be fined in a sum not exceeding One Hundred Dol-
lars (\$100) nor less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25).
