

ORDINANCE NO. 1333

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CALLING AND HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE ISSUE OF MANDATING THE ADDITION OF FLUORIDE TO THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM FOR THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the question has arisen of whether or not fluoride should be added by the Carroll Boone Water District to the water supplied to the municipal water system of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a special election should be held to determine this issue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1: That there be, and is hereby called, a special election to be held on Tuesday, April 4, 1989, at which election there shall be submitted to the electors of the city the question of whether the City Council should pass an ordinance that would allow the addition of fluoride to the municipal water system.

Section 2: Emergency Declared.


It is hereby found by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that an emergency is declared to exist, and is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from the date of its passage, approval and publication according to law.
