

ORDINANCE NO. 1336

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CALLING AND HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE ISSUE FOR THE CONTINUING MUNICIPAL FUNDING OF AMBULANCE, PARAMEDIC/EMT SERVICES AND OTHER CONSIDERATIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs Arkansas, has determined that a special election should be held to determine the continuation of municipal funding of ambulance, paramedic/EMT services and other related services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:


Section 1: That there be, and is hereby called, a special election to be held on Tuesday, April 4, 1989, to determine the continuation of municipal funding from the Act 990 sales tax revenue adopted in 1981 and from other sources for the present ambulance, paramedic/EMT services and other related services by the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas.

Section 2: Emergency Declared

It is hereby found by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that an emergency is declared to exist, and is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from the date of its passage, approval and publication according to law.
