

ORDINANCE NO. 1349

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A DUPLICATING MACHINE FOR THE CITY OFFICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS

Section 1. Bidding Requirements Waived

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the purchase of a new duplicating machine for the city offices are hereby waived. The bidding requirements are not deemed feasible or practical because of the need for an efficient machine due to the volume of copies of accounting, legal and administrative papers necessary to carry on the day-to-day business of the City of Eureka Springs, and the machine in question is in competitive range of other like machines.

Section 2. Contract Authorized

The Mayor and the Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Professional Business Systems of Rogers, AR for the supply of a Minolta copier, Model 470Z, Automatic Document Finder with ten bin sorter at a cost of \$7,038.80 including Sharp SF755 copier trade in, and with a service contract of \$475.00, for one year's service.

Section 3. Emergency Declared


