

ORDINANCE #1366

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2000 SERIES MOYNO FINAL SLUDGE RECYCLE PUMP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS

Section 1. Bidding Requirements Waived

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the purchase of a Final Sludge Recycle Pump are hereby waived. The bidding requirements are not deemed feasible or practical because the operation of the Waste Water Treatment Plant is dependent upon the remaining pump; because the demand upon this functional pump is in excess of its probable lifespan; because it is critical to maintaining effluent discharge limits which directly affect groundwater quality downstream; and because this is a matter of maintaining Public Health.

Section 2. Contract Authorized


The Mayor and the Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and delivered to contract with Jones & Sweany, Inc., Memphis, TN, for the delivery of a 2000 Series Moyno Final Sludge Recycle Pump for the sum of \$5,756.

Section 3. Emergency Declared


