

ORDINANCE #1370

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR
THE PURCHASE OF NEW POLICE VEHICLE, AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA
SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT

Section 1: Bidding Requirements Waived:

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the purchase of a reconditioned, equipped police patrol vehicle for a price not to exceed \$7,550.00, are hereby waived.

Section 2. Contract Authorized:

The Mayor and the Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Diversifleet, Inc. of Kansas City, KS for the delivery of a reconditioned low mileage police patrol vehicle. The Police Chief is authorized to negotiate for make, model, year and appropriate equipment.

Section 3. Emergency Declared.


The City Council of the City of Eureka Springs finds that no other apparent provider is available to offer this equipment at this savings and it is felt the purchasing of this vehicle is necessary for the welfare of the community. Therefore, a state of emergency is deemed to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after the date of its publication.
