

ORDINANCE NO. 1375

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE LIFT STATION PACKAGE UNITS FOR THE UNSEWERED AREA CITY PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS AND AMENDING ORIGINAL ORDINANCE #1364 DATED OCTOBER 10, 1989 TO CORRECT FINAL PRICE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS

Section 1. Bidding Requirements Waived

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the purchase of three lift station package units are hereby waived. The bidding requirements are not deemed feasible or practical because of the time schedule demands to install service in areas 4 through 11 of the city's unsewered area plan.

Section 2. Contract Authorized

The Mayor and the Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Pumps One, Inc., Hot Springs, AR for the delivery of three lift station package units at the cost of \$5,579.34 each, including tax and a \$150 assistance charge, making a final total of \$16,738.02.

Section 3. Emergency Declared



RE: Lift station package units

Dear Council Members:

On October 10, 1989 bidding was waived for the purchase of three lift station package units. The figure of \$9,795 was based on a telephone quote from Pumps One of Hot Springs. The invoice totaled \$16,738.

In checking with other firms who build this type of equipment, we find that the actual cost of building one of these units is approximately \$4,700 and the selling price is typically \$5,500. At the invoiced price of \$5,365 per unit, Pumps One still comes in as the least expensive.

This letter is to request approval for an additional \$6,943.80 to finalize the purchase of the three units.
