ORDINANCE NO. 1319

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING WATER RATES

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the present rates charged for water are insufficient to defray costs and expenditures incurred by the City in supplying waterworks; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide a supply of water, it is necessary to raise the rates charged for water.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1. That the first full paragraph of 10.04.02 is amended to read as follows:

The following monthly rates and charges for water service which the City Council hereby finds and declares are fair, reasonable, and necessary; and they are hereby fixed effective February ____, 1990:

	<u>Inside City Limits</u>	<u>Outside City Limits</u>
For the first 2,000 gallons of water consumption per month or portion thereof	From \$6.00 (minimum) to <hr/>	From \$12.00 (minimum) to <hr/>
For the next 8,000 gallons of water consumption per month or portion thereof	From \$2.20 per 1,000 gallons to <hr/>	From \$4.40 per 1,000 gallons to <hr/>
For the next 20,000 gallons of water consumption per month or portion thereof	From \$3.00 per 1,000 gallons to <hr/>	From \$6.00 per 1,000 gallons to <hr/>
For all water consumption in excess of 30,000 gallons per month	From \$2.45 per 1,000 gallons to <hr/>	From \$4.90 per 1,000 gallons to <hr/>

Section 2. All Ordinances and Resolutions and parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance is held to be unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.
